Qualifications

- A. Model a growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
- B. Undergraduate degree and seminary degree or equivalent training preferred.
- C. Experience successfully leading or assisting Children's Ministry in a medium to large size church.
- D. A passion, excitement and energy for Children's Ministry.
- E. Ascribes to theological convictions in the Apostle's Creed (understanding of Wesleyan theology helpful).

Responsibilities

- A. Relationally invest in children's ministry volunteers, parents and children.
- B. Provide training, evaluate resources and provide visionary leadership to equip the members of the Children' Ministries Team.
- C. Recruit new volunteers and offer appropriate training and resources in the areas they will be serving.
- D. Provide pastoral care to children and their families during times of need.
- E. Coordinate training of and ensure compliance with the Safe Sanctuary policies and procedures for all volunteers serving in children's ministry.
- F. Provide pastoral assimilation to new children and families.
- G. Coordinate budget preparation and administration for the assigned program ministries of the church.
- H. Office duties as necessary (answering the phone, making copies, etc.)

- I. Sunday morning preaching as necessary.

- J. Provide supervision for these areas of children's ministries:
 1. Sunday morning ministries
 2. Wednesday evening child care and program during Fall and Spring
 3. Outreach events to invite the community into the life of the church
 4. Annual activities – Vacation Bible School, Feeding programs and other special events
